Aggies at Home Trivia Competition Rules

Competition Format

- Competitions will be held via Zoom on the Kahoot interface
- Zoom meeting information will be sent out the day of the competition to all registered participants
- 4 categories per competition with 15 questions per category for a total of 60 questions
- Participants will have a maximum of 20 seconds to answer each question
- Questions and categories are randomly sorted
- Competition is split into 4 Rounds
- There will be a 2-minute break after Rounds 1 and 3
- There will be a 5-minute break after Round 2
- Prizes will be given to the top 5 participants from each competition
- The top participants from each competition will be invited back to compete in a "playoff" trivia competition the week of May 25th

General Rules

- Participants must register in Kahoot with their team name. No nicknames or other people's names will be accepted.
 - If you are a member of a team that has multiple Kahoot accounts participating, your Kahoot name must include both your team name and your first name (i.e. Team Ninjas - Sally)
- If a participant gets kicked out for a computer/internet reason, they will still be able to rejoin the Zoom meeting and Kahoot game. If this situation occurs, the participant will need to contact one of the hosts to inform them of the situation.
- It is recommended to use a second device or split screen in order to see both the question and answers
- Disclaimer: All meetings will be recorded for Rec Sports research and observation.
- No foul language or unsportsmanlike conduct will be tolerated. Hosts will be monitoring the chat function throughout the game.
- If foul language/unsportsmanlike conduct persists, the hosts have the ability to remove participants from the game. If removed, your team will not be allowed to compete in any other trivia competitions, and your team will be subject to disciplinary actions, as necessary.

Scoring

- Kahoot is the software that will be used for the competition
- Each question is worth a maximum of 1,000 points

- Points are awarded based on the speed of the response, the correctness of the response, and the participant's answer streak
- Speed:
 - The faster the correct response, the more points are awarded
 - Points are awarded based on the formula found on the Kahoot website here: https://support.kahoot.com/hc/en-us/articles/115002303908-How-to-toggle-points
- Correctness:
 - Correct answers can earn up to 1,000 points
 - Incorrect answers earn 0 points
- Answer Streak Bonus Points:
 - Up to 500 bonus points can be awarded for longer streaks
 - Streaks are made by answering multiple questions correctly in a row
 - For each streak, 100 bonus points are awarded

- Players can reach answer streaks higher than 6, but will only be awarded 500 bonus points thereafter
- An incorrect answer will reset answer streaks to x0
- Individual leaders will be announced after each round and game winners will be announced the next day in a followup email
- Team Scoring
 - If teams participate through different accounts (i.e. log in with different Zoom accounts and different Kahoot accounts), the final team score will be the average of all members' overall scores
 - If teams participate through a single Zoom and Kahoot account, then just that one score will be recorded as the team's final score

Prizes

- Rec Sports Spring Champion shirts will be awarded to each member of the top 5 teams
- Winning teams will be notified via email after the competition
- Captains of winning teams will be contacted at the end of the season (end of May) regarding claiming their prizes
- Larger prizes will be offered during playoff play
