- Charge for spectator admission at big games!
- money can go directly into your personal checking account
 - o Or sell prepackaged snacks and drinks or campus food trucks to come (great idea for tournaments)
- Host youth, skills camps or lessons for community/UCD students
- Work ICA events; easy money for 2-5 hours of work, doubles as team bonding, word of mouth advertising
- Sell or raffle leftover merch at games, on social media, tabling, etc
- Promote your donation link as much as possible!

- Officers recruit based on own/set guidelines by team
- Use social events to recruit/market your team
- Highlight not just skill & athletic accomplishments:
 - Academic accomplishments
 - Events/socials the club hosts
 - Alumni connections
 - Travel opportunities

You are trying to get them to choose you just as much as you choosing them!




Equipment Officer


